The 24th Workshop on Corporate Governance and Investment

September 19-20, 2025 Vaasa, Finland

Workshop Description:

The 24th Workshop on Corporate Governance and Investment (WCGI) will be held at the University of Vaasa on September 19-20, 2025.

The WCGI aims to serve as a forum for discussing the latest research on corporate governance, with a particular on the ways corporate governance mechanisms facilitate the efficient allocation of corporate investments and their implications for policy design. The WCGI also welcomes research on sustainable finance, broadly defined as investments that pursue objectives beyond financial returns. The WCGI covers a range of topics in corporate governance and investment, such as corporate boards, executive remuneration, ownership structure, capital markets, institutional investors, and regulation.

The WCGI will be a two-day event held in a single-track, plenary format. The WCGI offers an informal forum for lively collegial interaction, with ample time dedicated to open discussion.

About Vaasa:

Vaasa is the regional capital of Ostrobothnia, located on the west coast of Finland, with a population of approximately 70,000.

The easiest way to reach Vaasa is by flying via Helsinki or Stockholm, both of which offer connections from major international airports. Flights from Helsinki or Stockholm to Vaasa take approximately 50-60 minutes. Vaasa Airport is conveniently located just 9 kilometers southeast of the city center.

Another convenient option is to take advantage of Finland's well-connected railway network and travel to Vaasa by train. The journey from Helsinki Airport to Vaasa takes around 3½ to 4 hours, with 8-10 trains operating daily.
